JELLICOE STREET PIAZZA FACT SHEET

While our current focus is on public health and safety, we at the City of Canada Bay are continuing to plan and deliver for our community.

Majors Bay Road Shopping Village will soon be home to the new Jellicoe Street Piazza. This \$600,000 project is part of our plan to support our community and local businesses well into the future.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Through community consultation undertaken in 2018 and 2019, the investigation of a piazza was identified as a major priority of the Majors Bay Road Place Plan. This Plan was endorsed by Council on 18 June 2019.

The Majors Bay Road Place Plan seeks to foster a community that is well connected with their village centre and encourages a thriving business community. Proposed actions were identified within four themes:

- 1. Create an active and vibrant cultural centre
- 2. Improve transport accessibility
- 3. Enhance visual appeal and amenity
- Undertake activities to meet the needs and aspirations of residents, businesses and visitors.

PROJECT DELIVERABLES

A 103m² piazza space aligned with the existing footpath level, featuring:

- Public seating, positioned where possible, under trees
- New kerbside hedge plantings and trees
- A device charging station
- Storage for pop up furniture
- Power and water access for small community events
- Additional lighting including decorating uplighting of new trees
- Safety fencing and bollards.

Adjustments to parking and vehicle movements

- A vehicle turning bay will be created at the western end of Jellicoe Street resulting in the removal of two existing angled parking spaces
- Creation of four new parallel parking spaces on the southern side of Jellicoe Street by narrowing the footpath to 2.4m
- An overall net gain of two parking spaces
- An additional mobility parking space created on the northern side of Jellicoe Street
- Gallipoli Lane restricted to one-way southbound.
